- The presbytery helped connect my church to other nearby churches for a shared ministry effort
- My church has had its session records reviewed in an event the presbytery organized
- I or others at my church receive the presbytery eUpdate for Church Leaders, First Monday, or Constant Contact emails
- My church has supported someone discerning a call to ministry, attending seminary, or seeking training as a Commissioned Ruling Elder, with help from the presbytery Committee on Preparation for Ministry
- My church received grant monies from the presbytery (for example, a Peacemaking or Northminster grant), or from our synod
