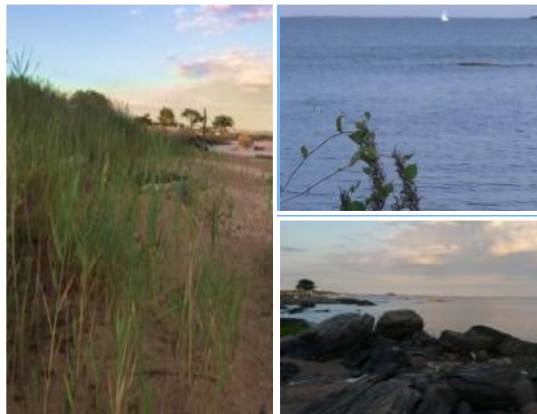


## Agenda
